## HEALTHCARE FOR ALL

The pandemic has severely burdened the public healthcare system in India and around the world. The healthcare sector has been under tremendous pressure to manage the medical equipment shortage and essential supplies to provide appropriate delivery and services.

As part of our effort to make quality healthcare more accessible to underprivileged communities, Cigniti is working on immediate relief and long-term humanitarian response work in the following three government hospitals:

**Belagavi Institute of Medical Sciences (BIMS), Karnataka** – Provided medical equipment and renovated the ICU ward to support India's fight against COVID-19. So far, 100,000 patients from remote areas have benefited from the project.



**Maternity and Child Health Care Center in Nalgonda district, Hyderabad** – The project addressed the acute shortage of NICU/SNCU beds and donated medical equipment for critically ill or premature newborn infants. As a result of this upgrade, the facility is able to serve about 1,000 infants per year.

**MNJ Institute of Oncology Regional Cancer Hospital, Hyderabad** – Supported a gynecology facility, offering essential medical equipment and services to 1,000 marginalized women annually. The facility will provide a green walk-in channel for women to reduce waiting times and gynecology referrals to other private or tertiary hospitals.
